Clarinet Lesson Policies 2021-2022

Dear students and parents,

Welcome to another semester of private clarinet lessons! Whether you are brand new or have been involved for many years, please read through my updated policies as some of them have been changed to fit the times.

Pricing and payments

\$20 per 30-minute lesson, \$15 per 30-minute virtual lesson (Note: lessons during high school class periods tend to be closer to 25 minutes.)

All private lessons will be in person except for the following cases:

- 1) Parent or student specifically requests virtual lessons
- 2) Student and teacher cannot find a mutually agreeable meeting time

Payments will be due at the beginning of each month. I will typically send a reminder by email with an estimated amount for each month. Check (written to Kevy Bailey), cash, or Paypal are all acceptable forms of payment.

For Paypal users, please select the 'Sending to a Friend' option when paying, otherwise a fee is extracted and I do not receive the entire payment.

Attendance

Attendance must be regular and punctual. (Students with a time slot at the beginning of a band period should assemble their instrument quickly and remember that they can socialize with their friends **after** class.) If a student arrives late for their lesson, they will only receive the remaining time available.

Make-up lessons will be given in the following cases:

a) Cancellations by the teacher.

b) Sick students. In the case of illness, a 24-hour notice is typically required, but any kind of notice will be accepted! If your child wakes up sick on the morning of their lesson, notify me immediately (preferably by text) and keep them home! A student who misses a lesson due to illness and has given the proper notification will receive a make-up lesson.

If the lesson is cancelled for reasons other than illness, I may choose to make up the lesson but have no obligation to do so. **This includes no-shows, inclement weather, school trips or other activities, birthday parties, athletic events, forgotten instrument, etc.**

Discontinuing Lessons

If during the school year you decide to discontinue lessons, 2 weeks advance notice is required (and very much appreciated!) This allows time to fill your child's time slot with another student.
